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I am a Principal Software Engineer with 19+ years designing and delivering scalable backend systems, distributed applications and enterprise software, with 50+ delivered projects across logistics, fintech, media, enterprise SaaS and Web3. I architected a logistics platform that processed 50M+ invoices for 60,000 couriers, and a wallet application that moved more than \$1 billion in volume.

My core expertise is Java, Kotlin, Node.js and TypeScript — REST and GraphQL APIs, distributed systems, and solution architecture. I have led engineering teams of up to 30 people while staying hands-on in design and implementation, defining architecture, technical roadmaps, engineering standards and delivery processes.

More recently I have worked on AI-assisted engineering workflows, integrating LLM agents into development and review processes and building tooling that turns natural language into working software, and on Web3-enabled applications, building backend services, wallet infrastructure, multi-chain integrations and developer tooling. What I care about is shipping systems that stay reliable in production.

At 33Labs (formerly 33Audits), I design and implement scalable backend services and application architecture for decentralized financial products.

The company began as a security auditing firm, which gave me daily experience preventing vulnerabilities in production systems. I work end to end — architecture, implementation, and automated testing — with security engineers involved throughout. This led me to a key conviction: review should start at the architecture stage, before any code is written. To support it, I built developer tooling and AI-assisted workflows that improved the team's productivity.

I defined software architecture, technical roadmaps, engineering standards and delivery processes, and built scalable backend services using Java, Kotlin, Node.js, TypeScript, MySQL/PostgreSQL and REST/GraphQL APIs.

Simpli started as a startup building a B2C mobile product and pivoted within its first year into a software house delivering custom distributed applications, scaling organically through consistent delivery and client satisfaction. Enclave is an application for secure digital asset management, built so non-technical users can onboard as smoothly as in a traditional web app. It combines Abstract Accounts, WebAuthn authentication and sponsored transactions. In a small team, I owned the product vision, usability and the entire frontend, and contributed to the backend services it relies on.

The most significant challenge was translating all the company's needs into a flexible application that could scale without requiring code modifications.
